



ACTIVITY TITLE: Getting to Know You – AGAIN!

DESCRIPTION: A discovery activity

SUGGESTED TIMELINE: Second Day Activity

MATERIALS:

- A. Index cards with job descriptions printed on them (from previous day)
- B. Index cards with names of staff who will be working with the students for the week. (From previous day)
- C. 6x9 manila envelopes

PROCEDURE:

1. Sort index cards into colors
2. Presenter should give each group (or each student) a collection of the color-coded cards enclosed in manila envelope.
3. Hand out the envelope to each group/student
4. Explain that on the “GO” signal, each group/student should correctly match the cards. When they have completed the task they should indicate that they are finished (Presenter can determine the format for this part of the activity – i.e. joined hands, circle of joined hands, locked elbow etc.)
5. When groups/students have matched all of the cards, they should signal the presenter using the decided format.
6. Presenter should hand out a Card #1 to first, #2 to second, #3 for third, etc. in case the #1 group has made an error.
7. Give each group points for their placement/participation.
(IMPORTANT – make sure each group gets some points – even if they came in last)

FOLLOW-UP: Assign points on Chart (If “Adventures in Television” chooses to have an ongoing point competition throughout the week)

EVALUATION: Student completion of activity/points awarded
